

## Bowling Green

Code: ANCMF-AU-ACF-BG-01 • Facility: Aged Care Facility • Frequency: daily

### Scope of Work

- Remove debris and litter from the bowling green surface.
- Sweep and clean the surrounding pathways and seating areas.
- Sanitize handrails and any touchpoints around the bowling green.
- Dust and wipe down any outdoor furniture and fixtures.
- Ensure all cleaning agents used are suitable for outdoor surfaces and safe for residents.

### Method

1. Begin by collecting and disposing of all visible debris and litter from the bowling green.
2. Use a broom to sweep the surface of the bowling green, ensuring all dirt and dust are removed.
3. Wipe down handrails and touchpoints with a disinfectant solution.
4. Dust and clean outdoor furniture using a damp cloth and appropriate cleaning solution.
5. Inspect the area for any remaining dirt or debris and repeat cleaning steps as necessary.

### Equipment

- Broom and dustpan
- Microfiber cloths
- Trash bags
- Outdoor vacuum cleaner
- Disinfectant solution

### Quality Criteria

| Performance Level | Criteria                                                                                                                 |
|-------------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| <b>Excellent</b>  | No visible debris or litter; surfaces are spotless and sanitized; all touchpoints are disinfected; no dust on furniture. |
| <b>Good</b>       | Minor debris present; surfaces are clean with minimal dust; most touchpoints are disinfected.                            |
| <b>Pass</b>       | Some debris present; surfaces are generally clean but may have some dust; touchpoints are partially disinfected.         |
| <b>Fail</b>       | Visible debris and litter; surfaces are dirty; touchpoints are not disinfected; dust is present on furniture.            |
