Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces, including shelves and containers.
- Sanitize all high-touch surfaces, including door handles and light switches.
- Mop the floor with an appropriate disinfectant solution.
- Wipe down all containers and ensure they are free from spills and residues.
- Remove any cobwebs from corners and ceilings.
- Ensure all cleaning agents are stored correctly and securely after use.

Method

- 1. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfiber cloth to capture dust particles effectively.
- 2. Use a disinfectant spray on high-touch surfaces and wipe with a clean cloth.
- 3. Prepare a mop bucket with a disinfectant solution and mop the floor, ensuring all areas are covered.

- 5. Inspect corners and ceilings for cobwebs and remove them using an extendable duster.
- 6. Check that all cleaning agents are returned to their designated storage areas and secured properly.

Quality Criteria

Pass	Basic cleaning completed, surfaces generally clean but may have some minor dust or marks. Acceptable standard for routine operations.
