Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces including shelves, tables, and chairs.
- · Vacuum carpeted areas and rugs.
- Mop hard floor surfaces.
- Sanitize high-touch areas such as door handles, light switches, and computer keyboards.
- Clean and polish glass surfaces including windows and display cases.
- Empty and sanitize waste bins.
- Organize and tidy reading materials and furniture.

Method

- 1. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfiber cloth to capture dust particles.
- 2. Vacuum all carpeted areas, ensuring to reach under furniture and in corners.
- 3. Mop hard floors with a suitable disinfectant solution, ensuring no residue is left.
- 4. Use a disinfectant wipe to sanitize all high-touch areas thoroughly.
- 5. Clean glass surfaces using a glass cleaner and a lint-free cloth for a streak-free finish.
- 6. Empty waste bins, replace liners, and sanitize the bin surfaces.
- 7. Reorganize reading materials and furniture to maintain a neat appearance.

Quality Criteria
