# **Nurses Station**

### **Scope of Work**

- Dust all surfaces including desks, shelves, and equipment.
- Sanitize all high-touch areas such as door handles, light switches, and telephones.
- · Vacuum carpeted areas and rugs.
- Mop hard floors with a disinfectant solution.
- Wipe down and disinfect computer keyboards and screens.
- Empty and sanitize waste bins.
- Clean and sanitize sinks and countertops.
- Ensure all cleaning supplies are restocked and stored properly.

#### Method

- 1. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfiber cloth to capture dust particles.
- 2. Apply a disinfectant to high-touch areas and allow it to dwell for the recommended time before wiping clean.
- 3. Vacuum carpets using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner to reduce allergens.
- 4. Mop floors with a disinfectant solution, ensuring no residue is left behind.
- 5. Use screen-safe wipes for electronic equipment to prevent damage.
- 6. Empty waste bins, replace liners, and sanitize the bin surfaces.
- 7. Clean sinks and countertops with a non-abrasive cleaner and disinfectant.
- 8. Check and restock cleaning supplies, ensuring all are stored in a designated area.
