# **Utility Closet**

Code: ANCMF-AU-CO-UC-01 • Facility: Commercial Office • Frequency: daily

### **Scope of Work**

- Dust all surfaces including shelves, ledges, and equipment.
- Sanitise all frequently touched surfaces such as door handles and light switches.
- Vacuum and mop the floor using a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Empty and sanitise rubbish bins.
- Wipe down and organise cleaning supplies and equipment.
- Check for and remove any cobwebs or visible dirt.
- Ensure all cleaning products are stored safely and correctly labelled.

#### Method

- 1. Begin by removing all items from shelves and surfaces.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a microfibre cloth, starting from the top and working downwards.
- 3. Sanitise all high-touch areas with an appropriate disinfectant.
- 4. Vacuum the floor thoroughly, paying attention to corners and edges.
- 5. Mop the floor using a damp mop and a neutral detergent, ensuring no excess water is left.
- 6. Empty rubbish bins and replace liners, then sanitise the bin interior and exterior.
- 7. Return all items to shelves, ensuring they are organised and labelled correctly.
- 8. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all areas meet the quality criteria.

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free of dust and marks; floors are spotless with no streaks; no odours present; all items are neatly organised and labelled; rubbish bins are clean and sanitised.
Good	Minor dust on high surfaces; floors are clean with minimal streaks; no strong odours; items are mostly organised; rubbish bins are clean but not sanitised.
Pass	Visible dust on multiple surfaces; floors have visible streaks; slight odours present; items are disorganised; rubbish bins are emptied but not cleaned.
Fail	Heavy dust accumulation; floors are dirty with visible debris; strong odours present; items are disorganised and not labelled; rubbish bins are overflowing or dirty.
