Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces, including pipes, ledges, and equipment.
- Sanitise high-touch areas such as door handles and light switches.
- Vacuum and mop floors using appropriate cleaning solutions.
- Remove rubbish and replace bin liners.
- Inspect and clean vents and air ducts for dust accumulation.
- Wipe down walls and remove any cobwebs.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with relevant safety standards.

Method

- 1. Prepare the area by removing any obstacles and ensuring adequate ventilation.
- 2. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 3. Dust all surfaces using microfibre cloths to capture dust effectively.
- 4. Sanitise high-touch areas with an appropriate disinfectant.
- 5. Vacuum the floor using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner.
- 6. Mop the floor with a neutral pH cleaner suitable for industrial environments.
- 7. Empty rubbish bins and replace liners, ensuring waste is disposed of according to facility guidelines.
- 8. Inspect and clean vents and air ducts using a vacuum attachment or dusting tool.
- 9. Wipe down walls with a damp cloth to remove any marks or cobwebs.
- 10. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all tasks are completed to standard.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free of dust and marks; floors are spotless and dry; no rubbish present; high-touch areas are fully sanitised; vents and ducts are clear of dust.
Good	Minor dust on non-critical surfaces; floors are clean with minimal streaks; rubbish bins are empty; high-touch areas are mostly sanitised; vents and ducts have minimal dust.
Pass	Noticeable dust on some surfaces; floors are clean but may have visible streaks; rubbish bins are mostly empty; high-touch areas are partially sanitised; vents and ducts have some dust.
Fail	Significant dust accumulation; floors are dirty or sticky; rubbish bins are full; high-touch areas are not sanitised; vents and ducts are clogged with dust.
