Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces including shelves, storage units, and equipment.
- Sanitise high-touch surfaces such as door handles and light switches.
- Organise and maintain a colour-coded cleaning system for all cleaning supplies.
- Empty rubbish bins and replace liners.
- Clean and sanitise the floor using appropriate mopping techniques.
- Ensure all cleaning equipment is stored neatly and safely.
- Check for and report any signs of pest infestation.

Method

- 1. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfibre cloth to capture dust and allergens.
- 2. Sanitise high-touch surfaces with a disinfectant solution, ensuring contact time as per manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. Organise cleaning supplies according to the colour-coded system, ensuring all items are clearly labelled and stored correctly.
- 4. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and dispose of waste according to facility guidelines.
- 5. Mop the floor using a damp mop and a neutral pH cleaner, ensuring no excess water is left on the floor.
- 6. Store all cleaning equipment in designated areas, ensuring no items are blocking walkways or exits.
- 7. Inspect the area for any signs of pests and report findings to the facility manager.

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free from dust and marks; high-touch areas are sanitised with no visible residue; supplies are perfectly organised and labelled; bins are empty and clean; floors are spotless with no water marks; equipment is neatly stored.
Good	Minor dust on high surfaces; high-touch areas are sanitised with minimal residue; supplies are mostly organised; bins are empty; floors are clean with slight water marks; equipment is stored correctly.
Pass	Noticeable dust on surfaces; high-touch areas sanitised but with visible residue; supplies are somewhat organised; bins are not overflowing; floors are mopped but with visible streaks; equipment is stored but not neatly.
Fail	Heavy dust accumulation; high-touch areas not sanitised; supplies are disorganised; bins are overflowing; floors are dirty or sticky; equipment is blocking walkways.
