# **Australian National Cleaning Management Framework (ANCMF)**

## **Bike Path**

Code: ANCMF-AU-GB-BP-01 • Facility: Government Building • Frequency: daily

### **Scope of Work**

- Remove all rubbish and debris from the bike path.
- Sweep and mop the path to remove dirt and stains.
- Sanitise high-touch surfaces such as railings and benches.
- Ensure all signage is clean and visible.
- Check and clean adjacent areas to prevent debris from encroaching onto the path.

#### Method

- 1. Inspect the bike path for rubbish and debris, removing all items and disposing of them in the appropriate rubbish bins.
- 2. Use a broom to sweep the entire path, focusing on corners and edges where debris accumulates.
- 3. Prepare a mop with a suitable cleaning solution and mop the path, ensuring all stains and marks are removed.
- 4. Sanitise high-touch surfaces using a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 5. Wipe down all signage with a damp cloth to ensure clarity and visibility.
- 6. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all areas meet the quality criteria.

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible rubbish or debris; path is spotless and dry; all high-touch surfaces are sanitised; signage is clean and fully legible.
Good	Minor debris present; path is clean with no visible stains; high-touch surfaces are mostly sanitised; signage is mostly clean and legible.
Pass	Some debris present; path has minor stains; high-touch surfaces are partially sanitised; signage is somewhat clean and legible.
Fail	Significant debris present; path is dirty with visible stains; high-touch surfaces are not sanitised; signage is dirty and illegible.
