Scope of Work

- Dust all horizontal surfaces including ledges, skirting boards, and window sills.
- Vacuum all carpeted areas and mats.
- Mop hard floors using a damp mop and appropriate cleaning solution.
- Wipe down walls and doors to remove marks and fingerprints.
- Clean and sanitise high-touch areas such as door handles, light switches, and handrails.
- Empty rubbish bins and replace liners.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with Australian workplace health and safety requirements.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with all necessary equipment and supplies, ensuring colour-coded cleaning systems are used to prevent cross-contamination.
- 2. Begin by dusting all horizontal surfaces using a microfibre cloth.
- 3. Vacuum carpeted areas thoroughly, paying special attention to corners and edges.
- 4. Mop hard floors with a damp mop, using a neutral pH cleaning solution suitable for the floor type.
- 5. Wipe down walls and doors with a damp cloth to remove any visible marks.
- 6. Sanitise high-touch areas using a disinfectant spray and cloth.
- 7. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and ensure bins are clean and odour-free.
- 8. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all tasks are completed to the required standard.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria	
Excellent	No visible dust or debris on any surfaces; floors are spotless with no streaks; all high-touch areas are sanitised and free of marks; bins are empty and odour-free.	
Good	Minor dust on less accessible surfaces; floors are clean with minimal streaks; high-touch areas are mostly sanitised; bins are empty but may have slight odour.	
Pass	Visible dust on some surfaces; floors have noticeable streaks; some high-touch areas missed; bins are emptied but not cleaned.	
Fail	Significant dust and debris on surfaces; floors are dirty and streaked; high-touch areas are not sanitised; bins are full or have strong odour.
