Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces including shelves, benches, and equipment.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces such as door handles and light switches.
- Empty and clean rubbish bins, replacing liners as needed.
- Mop floors with appropriate cleaning solution.
- Organise and tidy cleaning supplies and equipment.
- Check and refill consumables such as hand sanitiser and soap.
- Ensure all cleaning chemicals are stored safely and labelled correctly.

Method

- 1. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfibre cloth to capture dust effectively.
- 2. Sanitise high-touch areas with a disinfectant spray, ensuring contact time as per product instructions.
- 3. Empty rubbish bins, clean with a disinfectant wipe, and replace liners.
- 4. Prepare a mop bucket with a neutral pH cleaning solution and mop the floor, starting from the farthest corner and moving towards the exit.
- 5. Organise cleaning supplies on shelves, ensuring labels are facing outward for easy identification.
- 6. Check consumable levels and refill as necessary, ensuring all dispensers are functioning correctly.
- 7. Inspect chemical storage for compliance with safety standards, ensuring all containers are sealed and labelled.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free of dust and marks; high-touch areas are sanitised with no visible residue; floors are spotless with no streaks; rubbish bins are empty and clean; supplies are neatly organised and fully stocked; all chemicals are correctly labelled and stored.
Good	Minor dust on less accessible surfaces; high-touch areas are mostly sanitised; floors have minimal streaks; rubbish bins are empty but may have minor residue; supplies are organised with minor disarray; most chemicals are labelled and stored correctly.
Pass	Noticeable dust on surfaces; some high-touch areas missed during sanitising; floors have visible streaks; rubbish bins are not fully clean; supplies are disorganised; some chemicals are not labelled or stored correctly.
Fail	Significant dust accumulation; high-touch areas are not sanitised; floors are dirty; rubbish bins are full or unclean; supplies are in disarray; chemicals are improperly labelled or stored.
