# **Waste Room**

Code: ANCMF-AU-H-WR-02 • Facility: Hospitality • Frequency: daily

#### **Scope of Work**

- Remove all rubbish and waste materials from bins and surrounding areas.
- Sanitise rubbish bins and surrounding surfaces to prevent odours and bacterial growth.
- Sweep and mop floors to remove debris and spills.
- Wipe down walls and doors to remove marks and stains.
- Ensure proper segregation of waste according to colour-coded systems.
- Inspect for and report any signs of pest activity.

#### Method

- 1. Begin by removing all rubbish from bins and surrounding areas, ensuring proper waste segregation.
- 2. Sanitise bins using appropriate cleaning agents, focusing on lids and handles.
- 3. Sweep the entire floor area to remove loose debris.
- 4. Prepare a mop with a suitable cleaning solution and mop the floor thoroughly.
- 5. Wipe down walls and doors with a disinfectant solution, paying attention to high-touch areas.
- 6. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all tasks are completed to standard.

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible waste or debris; bins are sanitised and odour-free; floors and walls are spotless; no pest activity detected.
Good	Minor debris present; bins are mostly sanitised with slight odour; floors and walls have minor marks; no pest activity detected.
Pass	Some debris present; bins have noticeable odour; floors and walls have visible marks; no pest activity detected.
Fail	Significant debris present; bins are unsanitised with strong odour; floors and walls are heavily marked; pest activity detected.
