Scope of Work

- Remove all rubbish and dispose of it in designated rubbish bins.
- · Sanitise all high-touch surfaces including door handles, light switches, and railings.
- Clean and mop the floor with a disinfectant solution.
- Wipe down walls and surfaces to remove any visible dirt or stains.
- Ensure all cleaning is performed using a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Check and refill hand sanitiser dispensers as needed.
- Ensure all cleaning supplies and equipment are stored safely and securely after use.

Method

- 1. Begin by donning appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) including gloves and masks.
- 2. Collect all rubbish and dispose of it in the designated bins.
- 3. Use a colour-coded cloth to wipe down all high-touch surfaces with a hospital-grade disinfectant.
- 4. Prepare a mop bucket with a disinfectant solution and mop the entire floor area, ensuring to reach all corners.
- 5. Use a separate colour-coded cloth to clean walls and other surfaces, ensuring no cross-contamination occurs.
- 6. Check hand sanitiser dispensers and refill as necessary.
- 7. Inspect the area to ensure all tasks have been completed to the required standard.
- 8. Store all cleaning equipment and supplies in the designated storage area.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible dirt or stains; all surfaces sanitised; no odours; hand sanitiser dispensers full; no rubbish present; compliance with infection control standards.
Good	Minor visible dirt; all high-touch surfaces sanitised; faint odours; hand sanitiser dispensers mostly full; minimal rubbish present.
Pass	Some visible dirt; most high-touch surfaces sanitised; noticeable odours; hand sanitiser dispensers partially full; some rubbish present.
Fail	Visible dirt and stains; high-touch surfaces not sanitised; strong odours; hand sanitiser dispensers empty; rubbish overflowing; non-compliance with infection control standards.
