# Australian National Cleaning Management Framework (ANCMF)

## **Scope of Work**

- Dust all horizontal surfaces including equipment, ledges, and furniture.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces such as bed rails, door handles, and light switches.
- Clean and sanitise the patient bed and surrounding area.
- Empty and sanitise rubbish bins.
- Vacuum and mop floors using a colour-coded system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Clean and sanitise the ensuite toilet and sink area.
- Ensure all cleaning activities adhere to infection control protocols.

#### Method

- 1. Prepare cleaning trolley with appropriate colour-coded cloths and mops.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a damp microfibre cloth to capture dust and prevent dispersal.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch areas with hospital-grade disinfectant.
- 4. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and sanitise bin surfaces.
- 5. Vacuum floors using a HEPA-filtered vacuum cleaner.
- 6. Mop floors with a neutral detergent, ensuring no residue is left.
- 7. Clean ensuite facilities with appropriate bathroom cleaners, ensuring all surfaces are sanitised.

• Colour-coded microfibre cloths and mops

• Hospital-grade disinfectant

- HEPA-filtered vacuum cleaner
- Neutral detergent

- Bathroom cleaner
- Cleaning trolley

# **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean and free of dust, stains, and marks. No odours present. High-touch areas are sanitised and dry. Floors are spotless and dry. Rubbish bins are empty and sanitised. Compliance with infection control protocols is evident.
Good	Most surfaces are clean with minimal dust or marks. No strong odours. High-touch areas are sanitised. Floors are clean with minor spots. Rubbish bins are empty. Infection control protocols are mostly followed.
Pass	Surfaces have some dust or marks. Mild odours may be present. High-touch areas are mostly sanitised. Floors have visible dirt or spots. Rubbish bins are not overflowing. Infection control protocols are partially followed.
Fail	Surfaces are visibly dirty with dust and marks. Strong odours present. High-touch areas are not sanitised. Floors are dirty with visible debris. Rubbish bins are full or overflowing. Infection control protocols are not followed.
