Code: ANCMF-AU-HF-DR-01 • Facility: Healthcare Facility • Frequency: daily

Scope of Work

- Dust all horizontal surfaces including equipment, benches, and window sills.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces such as door handles, light switches, and dialysis chairs.
- Clean and mop floors using a colour-coded system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Empty and sanitise rubbish bins, ensuring proper waste segregation.
- Wipe down and sanitise all medical equipment surfaces.
- Ensure all cleaning is conducted in accordance with infection control guidelines.

Method

1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with all necessary supplies, ensuring colour-coded cloths and mops are used.
2. Dust all surfaces using a damp microfibre cloth to capture dust and prevent dispersal.
3. Sanitise high-touch areas with an approved disinfectant, allowing appropriate contact time.
4. Use a mop with a disinfectant solution to clean the floors, starting from the farthest corner and moving towards the exit.
5. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and sanitise the bin surfaces.
6. Wipe down all medical equipment with a disinfectant wipe, ensuring no residue is left.

Equipment

- Colour-coded microfibre cloths and mops
- Approved disinfectant solutions
- Cleaning trolley
- Rubbish bin liners
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean with no dust or smudges; high-touch areas are sanitised with no residue; floors are spotless and dry; no odours present; bins are empty and sanitised.
Good	Minor dust on non-critical surfaces; high-touch areas are mostly sanitised; floors are clean with minimal streaks; bins are empty but not sanitised.
Pass	Noticeable dust on surfaces; some high-touch areas missed; floors are clean but wet; bins are emptied but not sanitised.
Fail	Visible dust and dirt on surfaces; high-touch areas not sanitised; floors are dirty or sticky; bins are full or overflowing.
