# **Nuclear Medicine**

## **Scope of Work**

- Sanitising all surfaces including benches, equipment, and high-touch areas.
- Dusting and wiping all horizontal and vertical surfaces.
- Vacuuming and mopping floors with appropriate disinfectants.
- Emptying and sanitising rubbish bins.
- Cleaning and sanitising sinks and taps.
- Ensuring all cleaning activities comply with infection control protocols.

#### Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with colour-coded cleaning cloths and appropriate disinfectants.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a damp microfibre cloth to minimise airborne particles.
- 3. Sanitise all high-touch areas including door handles, light switches, and equipment controls.
- 4. Vacuum floors using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner to capture fine particles.
- 5. Mop floors with a hospital-grade disinfectant, ensuring no residue is left.
- 6. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and sanitise the bin interior and exterior.
- 7. Clean sinks and taps with a non-abrasive cleaner and sanitise thoroughly.

- · Colour-coded microfibre cloths
- HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner
- Cleaning trolley

- Hospital-grade disinfectants
- Mop and bucket with wringer
- Rubbish bin liners

## **Quality Criteria**

| <b>Performance Level</b> | Criteria  |

| Excellent                | All surfaces are visibly clean and sanitised with no dust or smudges. Floors are spotless with no residue. No odours present. High-touch areas are sanitised and free of fingerprints. Compliance with infection control protocols is fully documented. |
| Good                     | Surfaces are clean with minimal dust or smudges. Floors are clean with slight residue in corners. No strong odours. High-touch areas are mostly sanitised. Minor documentation gaps in infection control protocols.                                     |
| Pass                     | Surfaces have some dust or smudges. Floors are clean but with noticeable residue. Mild odours present. High-touch areas are inconsistently sanitised. Documentation of infection control protocols is incomplete.                                       |
| Fail                     | Surfaces are visibly dirty with dust and smudges. Floors are dirty with significant residue.  Strong odours present. High-touch areas are not sanitised. Infection control protocols are not followed or documented.                                    |
