Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces, including shelves and storage units.
- Sanitise high-touch areas such as door handles and light switches.
- Mop floors with a disinfectant solution.
- Empty and sanitise rubbish bins.
- Ensure all cleaning activities adhere to infection control guidelines.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with colour-coded cleaning cloths and solutions.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a damp microfibre cloth to minimise airborne particles.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch areas with an approved disinfectant, ensuring contact time as per manufacturer's instructions.
- 4. Mop the floor using a two-bucket system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 5. Dispose of waste in designated rubbish bins and replace liners.
- 6. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all areas meet quality criteria.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean and free from dust. No streaks or residue on floors. High-touch areas are sanitised and have no visible marks. No odours present.
Good	Minor dust on non-critical surfaces. Floors are clean with minimal streaks. High-touch areas are mostly sanitised with few marks. No strong odours present.
Pass	Noticeable dust on some surfaces. Floors have visible streaks. High-touch areas have some marks. Mild odours may be present.
Fail	Significant dust accumulation. Floors are dirty with streaks and residue. High-touch areas are visibly dirty. Strong odours present.
