Scope of Work

- Sanitising all surfaces including bed frames, side tables, and medical equipment.
- Dusting and wiping all horizontal surfaces including window sills and ledges.
- Mopping floors with hospital-grade disinfectant.
- Emptying and sanitising rubbish bins.
- Cleaning and sanitising sinks and taps.
- Ensuring all high-touch areas are thoroughly cleaned and sanitised.
- Checking and restocking hand sanitiser dispensers.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with colour-coded cleaning cloths and hospital-grade disinfectants.
- 2. Begin by dusting and wiping all horizontal surfaces using a damp microfibre cloth.
- 3. Sanitise all high-touch areas including door handles, light switches, and bed controls.
- 4. Empty rubbish bins and replace liners, then sanitise the bin exterior.
- 5. Clean and sanitise sinks and taps, ensuring no water spots remain.
- 6. Mop the floor using a two-bucket system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 7. Inspect the room for any missed areas and ensure all surfaces are dry and free of streaks.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean and sanitised; no dust or debris present; no streaks or water spots; all high-touch areas are sanitised; no odours detected.
Good	Surfaces are clean with minimal dust; high-touch areas sanitised; minor streaks or water spots may be present; no strong odours.
Pass	Surfaces are generally clean; some dust or minor debris present; high-touch areas mostly sanitised; some odours may be present.
Fail	Visible dirt or dust on surfaces; high-touch areas not sanitised; streaks or water spots present; strong odours detected.
