Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces, including equipment, shelves, and ledges.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces such as doorknobs, light switches, and telecommunication devices.
- Vacuum all carpeted areas and mop hard floors using a colour-coded system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Empty and sanitise rubbish bins, ensuring proper waste segregation as per healthcare standards.
- Clean and polish glass surfaces and partitions.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with infection control protocols.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with appropriate colour-coded cloths and mops.
- 2. Begin by dusting all surfaces using a microfibre cloth to capture dust particles effectively.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch areas with a hospital-grade disinfectant, ensuring contact time as per manufacturer's instructions.
- 4. Vacuum carpets using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner to minimise airborne particles.
- 5. Mop hard floors with a neutral detergent, using a damp mop technique to prevent slip hazards.
- 6. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and sanitise the bin interior and exterior.
- 7. Inspect all areas for cleanliness and rectify any missed spots.

- HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner
- Cleaning trolley

- Hospital-grade disinfectant
- Colour-coded mop and bucket system Rubbish bin liners

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean and free of dust. High-touch areas are sanitised with no visible residue. Floors are spotless with no streaks or marks. No odours present. Rubbish bins are empty and sanitised.
Good	Minor dust on non-essential surfaces. High-touch areas are mostly sanitised with minimal residue. Floors have slight streaks. No strong odours. Rubbish bins are empty but not fully sanitised.
Pass	Noticeable dust on surfaces. High-touch areas partially sanitised. Floors have visible marks. Mild odours present. Rubbish bins not fully emptied or sanitised.
Fail	Significant dust accumulation. High-touch areas not sanitised. Floors are dirty with visible debris. Strong odours present. Rubbish bins overflowing and unsanitised.
