# Australian National Cleaning Management Framework (ANCMF)

# **Crane Area**

Code: ANCMF-AU-I-CA-02 • Facility: Industrial • Frequency: daily

#### **Scope of Work**

- Dust all surfaces including crane controls, railings, and platforms.
- Sanitise high-touch areas such as control panels and handrails.
- Remove rubbish and debris from the area.
- Vacuum or sweep floors to remove dust and particles.
- Mop floors with appropriate cleaning solution to remove stains and spills.
- Inspect and clean any visible grease or oil spills promptly.

#### Method

- 1. Begin by removing all rubbish and debris from the area and dispose of it in the designated rubbish bins.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a microfibre cloth, starting from the highest points and working downwards.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch areas using a suitable sanitising solution, ensuring all surfaces are thoroughly wiped.
- 4. Vacuum or sweep the floor to remove dust and particles, paying special attention to corners and edges.
- 5. Mop the floor using a colour-coded mop and bucket system, ensuring the use of appropriate cleaning solutions for industrial areas.
- 6. Inspect the area for any remaining grease or oil spills and clean using a degreaser if necessary.

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free from dust and debris; high-touch areas are sanitised and free from smudges; floors are spotless with no visible stains or spills; no odours present.
Good	Minor dust on non-essential surfaces; high-touch areas mostly sanitised; floors have minimal stains; no strong odours present.
Pass	Noticeable dust on some surfaces; high-touch areas partially sanitised; floors have visible stains; slight odours present.
Fail	Significant dust accumulation; high-touch areas not sanitised; floors are dirty with multiple stains; strong odours present.
