Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces including equipment, pipes, and ledges.
- Sanitise high-touch surfaces such as door handles and light switches.
- Vacuum and mop floors using a colour-coded system to prevent cross-contamination.
- Empty rubbish bins and replace liners.
- Wipe down walls and remove any cobwebs.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with relevant Australian health and safety standards.

Method

- 1. Prepare the area by removing any obstacles and ensuring safety signs are in place.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a microfibre cloth to capture dust particles effectively.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch surfaces with an approved disinfectant, ensuring contact time as per manufacturer's instructions.
- 4. Vacuum the floor using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner to minimise airborne dust.
- 5. Mop the floor with a neutral pH cleaner, ensuring no residue is left behind.
- 6. Dispose of rubbish in designated bins and replace liners.
- 7. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all areas meet the quality criteria.

Quality Criteria

| Performance Level | Criteria |
|-------------------|---|
| Excellent | All surfaces are free of dust and marks; floors are spotless with no residue; high-touch surfaces are sanitised and free of smudges; no rubbish present; air is fresh with no odours. |
| Good | Minor dust on non-essential surfaces; floors are clean with minimal residue; high-touch surfaces are mostly sanitised; rubbish bins are empty; air is neutral. |
| Pass | Noticeable dust on surfaces; floors have some residue; high-touch surfaces are partially sanitised; rubbish bins are not overflowing; slight odour present. |
| Fail | Significant dust accumulation; floors are dirty with visible residue; high-touch surfaces are unsanitised; rubbish bins are full; strong odour present. |
