Australian National Cleaning Management Framework (ANCMF)

Perimeter Road

Code: ANCMF-AU-I-PR-03 • Facility: Industrial • Frequency: daily

Scope of Work

- Remove all rubbish and debris from the perimeter road.
- Sweep and clean the road surface to remove dust and dirt.
- Sanitise any high-touch surfaces such as gates and barriers.
- Ensure all drains and gutters are free from blockages and debris.
- Inspect and clean any signage for visibility and cleanliness.

Method

- 1. Conduct a visual inspection of the perimeter road to identify areas requiring attention.
- 2. Use a broom and dustpan to sweep debris and collect rubbish.
- 3. Utilise a high-pressure hose to clean the road surface where necessary.
- 4. Apply a sanitising solution to high-touch surfaces using a colour-coded cleaning system.
- 5. Check and clear drains and gutters of any obstructions.
- 6. Wipe down signage with a damp cloth to ensure visibility and cleanliness.

- Broom and dustpan
- Sanitising solution
- Rubbish bags

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible rubbish or debris; road surface is clean and free of dust; all high-touch surfaces are sanitised; drains and gutters are clear; signage is clean and legible.
Good	Minor dust or debris present; high-touch surfaces mostly sanitised; drains and gutters mostly clear; signage is mostly clean and legible.
Pass	Some visible rubbish or debris; high-touch surfaces partially sanitised; drains and gutters partially blocked; signage is partially clean and legible.
Fail	Significant rubbish or debris present; road surface is dirty; high-touch surfaces not sanitised; drains and gutters blocked; signage is dirty and illegible.
