Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces including tables, chairs, and equipment.
- Vacuum all carpeted areas and spot clean stains.
- Mop hard floors with appropriate cleaning solution.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces including door handles, light switches, and remote controls.
- Empty rubbish bins and replace liners.
- Clean and sanitise any whiteboards or presentation equipment.
- Ensure all cleaning is conducted using colour-coded cleaning systems to prevent cross-contamination.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with all necessary supplies and equipment, ensuring colour-coded cloths and mops are used.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a microfibre cloth, starting from the highest point and working downwards.
- 3. Vacuum carpeted areas thoroughly, paying special attention to corners and edges.
- 4. Mop hard floors using a neutral pH cleaner, ensuring no residue is left.
- 5. Sanitise high-touch surfaces with a disinfectant solution, allowing appropriate contact time.
- 6. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and dispose of waste according to facility protocols.
- 7. Wipe down and sanitise whiteboards and presentation equipment, ensuring no streaks or residue remain.

- Neutral pH floor cleaner

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free of dust and marks; floors are spotless with no residue; high-touch areas are sanitised with no visible fingerprints; rubbish bins are empty and clean; no odours present.
Good	Minor dust on high surfaces; floors are clean with minimal residue; high-touch areas are mostly sanitised; rubbish bins are emptied but may have minor marks; faint odours may be present.
Pass	Noticeable dust on surfaces; floors have visible residue or stains; high-touch areas are partially sanitised; rubbish bins are not emptied or have visible waste; noticeable odours present.
Fail	Excessive dust and dirt on surfaces; floors are dirty with significant residue or stains; high-touch areas are not sanitised; rubbish bins are overflowing; strong odours present.
