Scope of Work

- Dusting all surfaces including shelves, ledges, and equipment.
- Sweeping and mopping floors to remove dirt and debris.
- Sanitising high-touch areas such as door handles and light switches.
- Emptying and cleaning rubbish bins.
- Cleaning and sanitising any spillages immediately.
- Ensuring all cleaning equipment is stored safely and correctly after use.

Method

- 1. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 2. Begin by dusting from top to bottom to ensure all surfaces are free from dust.
- 3. Sweep the floor thoroughly to remove loose dirt and debris.
- 4. Mop the floor using a suitable cleaning solution, ensuring it is left dry to prevent slips.
- 5. Sanitise all high-touch areas with an appropriate disinfectant.
- 6. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and clean the bins with a disinfectant.
- 7. Inspect the area to ensure all tasks are completed to standard.

- Personal protective equipment (PPE)

Quality Criteria

• Dustpan and broom

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are free from dust and marks; floors are spotless and dry; no odours present; bins are empty and clean; high-touch areas are sanitised and visibly clean.
Good	Minor dust on high surfaces; floors are clean but may have slight marks; no strong odours; bins are emptied but may have slight residue; high-touch areas are mostly sanitised.
Pass	Noticeable dust on surfaces; floors have visible marks; slight odours present; bins are emptied but not cleaned; high-touch areas are partially sanitised.
Fail	Heavy dust accumulation; floors are dirty and wet; strong odours present; bins are full or dirty; high-touch areas are not sanitised.
