Scope of Work

- Dust all surfaces including shelves, ledges, and equipment.
- Sanitise high-touch areas such as door handles, light switches, and trolley handles.
- Vacuum all carpeted areas and mop hard floors.
- Empty rubbish bins and replace liners.
- Clean and organise storage areas to prevent clutter.
- Inspect for and remove any cobwebs or insect presence.
- Ensure all cleaning supplies are stored safely and correctly.

Method

- 1. Begin by dusting all surfaces from top to bottom to prevent recontamination.
- 2. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to sanitise high-touch areas, ensuring cross-contamination is avoided.
- 3. Vacuum carpeted areas using a HEPA-filter vacuum cleaner to capture dust and allergens.
- 4. Mop hard floors with a neutral pH cleaner to maintain surface integrity.
- 5. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and ensure bins are clean and odour-free.
- 6. Organise stock and cleaning supplies to maintain a tidy and efficient workspace.
- 7. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all tasks are completed to standard.

Quality Criteria

| Excellent | All surfaces are visibly clean and free of dust. High-touch areas are sanitised and free of smudges. Floors are spotless with no debris. Rubbish bins are empty and odour-free. Stock is neatly organised. |
| Good | Minor dust on less accessible surfaces. High-touch areas are mostly clean. Floors are clean with minimal debris. Rubbish bins are empty but may have slight odour. Stock is mostly organised. |
| Pass | Noticeable dust on surfaces. High-touch areas show some smudges. Floors have visible debris. Rubbish bins are not overflowing but have noticeable odour. Stock is somewhat disorganised. |
| Fail | Heavy dust accumulation. High-touch areas are visibly dirty. Floors are dirty with significant debris. Rubbish bins are overflowing and have strong odour. Stock is disorganised and cluttered. |
