# **Window Display**

Code: ANCMF-AU-R-WD-01 • Facility: Retail • Frequency: daily

### **Scope of Work**

- Remove all visible dirt, dust, and debris from window surfaces.
- Sanitise window glass to remove smudges, fingerprints, and streaks.
- Dust and wipe down window frames and sills.
- Clean and sanitise any display items within the window area.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with Australian workplace health and safety requirements.

#### Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with all necessary equipment and supplies, ensuring colour-coded cleaning systems are used to prevent cross-contamination.
- 2. Use a microfibre cloth to dust window frames and sills.
- 3. Apply a suitable glass cleaner to the window surface and wipe with a squeegee, ensuring no streaks are left.
- 4. Sanitise the window glass with an appropriate sanitising solution.
- 5. Inspect the window display for any remaining dirt or smudges and repeat cleaning if necessary.
- 6. Dispose of any rubbish in the designated rubbish bin and ensure the area is tidy.

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	Windows are completely free of dirt, smudges, and streaks; frames and sills are dust-free; display items are spotless and sanitised.
Good	Minor smudges or streaks visible only upon close inspection; frames and sills mostly dust-free; display items are clean.
Pass	Visible smudges or streaks from a distance; some dust on frames and sills; display items are mostly clean.
Fail	Obvious dirt, smudges, or streaks visible from a distance; significant dust on frames and sills; display items are visibly dirty.
