# Australian National Cleaning Management Framework (ANCMF)

## **Aircraft Wash**

Code: ANCMF-AU-TH-AW-01 • Facility: Transportation Hub • Frequency: daily

#### **Scope of Work**

- Thorough cleaning of aircraft exterior surfaces including fuselage, wings, and tail.
- Sanitising of all touchpoints such as door handles and service panels.
- Removal of dirt, grime, and contaminants from aircraft surfaces.
- · Application of appropriate cleaning agents to prevent corrosion and maintain surface integrity.
- Use of colour-coded cleaning systems to prevent cross-contamination.
- Proper disposal of cleaning waste in designated rubbish bins.

#### Method

- 1. Inspect the aircraft for any visible dirt or contaminants.
- 2. Prepare cleaning solutions according to manufacturer instructions and safety data sheets.
- 3. Apply cleaning solution using appropriate equipment, ensuring even coverage.
- 4. Rinse thoroughly with water to remove all cleaning agents and residues.
- 5. Dry surfaces using clean, lint-free cloths or air drying methods.
- 6. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all areas meet cleanliness standards.

- High-pressure water hoses
- Microfibre cloths

Environmentally friendly cleaning agents

- Cleaning trolleys with colour-coded buckets
- Non-abrasive cleaning pads
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)

### **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible dirt or streaks; all surfaces are dry and free of residues; touchpoints are sanitised; no odours present.
Good	Minor streaks or water spots; surfaces mostly dry; touchpoints sanitised; no strong odours.
Pass	Some visible dirt or streaks; surfaces may be damp; touchpoints mostly sanitised; slight odours may be present.
Fail	Visible dirt, streaks, or residues; surfaces wet; touchpoints not sanitised; strong odours present.
