

Engine Run-up Area

Code: ANCMF-AU-TH-ERA-01 • Facility: Transportation Hub • Frequency: daily

Scope of Work

- Remove all debris and rubbish from the area.
- Thoroughly clean and sanitise all surfaces, including floors and walls.
- Ensure all drains are clear and free from obstructions.
- Utilise colour-coded cleaning systems to prevent cross-contamination.
- Conduct regular inspections for oil spills and other contaminants.
- Ensure all cleaning agents are environmentally friendly and compliant with Australian standards.

Method

1. Inspect the area for any debris or rubbish and remove it using appropriate PPE.
2. Use a high-pressure washer to clean the floor surfaces, ensuring all oil and grease are removed.
3. Apply a suitable degreaser to stubborn stains and scrub with a brush.
4. Rinse the area thoroughly with water and ensure all cleaning agents are removed.
5. Sanitise all surfaces using an approved sanitising solution.
6. Check and clear all drains, ensuring they are free from blockages.
7. Conduct a final inspection to ensure all cleaning tasks are completed to standard.

Equipment

- High-pressure washer
- Degreaser and sanitising solutions
- PPE including gloves and safety goggles
- Colour-coded cleaning cloths and mops
- Brushes and scrubbing pads
- Rubbish bags and bins

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible debris or rubbish; all surfaces are spotless and free from stains; drains are clear and odour-free; no visible oil or grease; all cleaning agents are fully rinsed off.
Good	Minor debris or rubbish present; surfaces mostly clean with minimal stains; drains mostly clear with no significant odours; minimal oil or grease visible.
Pass	Some debris or rubbish present; surfaces have noticeable stains; drains have minor blockages or odours; some oil or grease visible.
Fail	Significant debris or rubbish present; surfaces are heavily stained; drains are blocked or have strong odours; significant oil or grease visible.
