Scope of Work

- Dust all horizontal surfaces including ledges, windowsills, and furniture.
- Sanitise all high-touch surfaces such as door handles, light switches, and taps.
- Vacuum all carpeted areas and mop hard floors using a colour-coded system.
- Empty and sanitise rubbish bins, replacing liners as needed.
- Clean and sanitise any visible stains or spills immediately.
- Ensure all cleaning activities comply with Australian infection control guidelines.

Method

- 1. Prepare the cleaning trolley with all necessary supplies, ensuring colour-coded cloths and mops are used.
- 2. Dust all surfaces using a microfibre cloth, starting from the highest point and working downwards.
- 3. Sanitise high-touch areas with an approved disinfectant, allowing appropriate contact time.
- 4. Vacuum carpets using a HEPA-filtered vacuum cleaner to minimise airborne particles.
- 5. Mop hard floors with a neutral detergent, ensuring no residue is left behind.
- 6. Dispose of rubbish in accordance with local waste management regulations.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All surfaces are visibly clean and free from dust, dirt, and stains. No odours present. High-touch areas are sanitised and dry. Floors are spotless and dry. Rubbish bins are empty and sanitised.
Good	Minor dust or smudges on less than 5% of surfaces. No strong odours. High-touch areas are sanitised. Floors are clean with minimal streaks. Rubbish bins are empty.
Pass	Noticeable dust or smudges on less than 10% of surfaces. Mild odours present. High-touch areas are mostly sanitised. Floors are generally clean. Rubbish bins are not overflowing.
Fail	Visible dust, dirt, or stains on more than 10% of surfaces. Strong odours present. High-touch areas are not sanitised. Floors are dirty or sticky. Rubbish bins are overflowing.
