Sculpture Garden

Code: ANCMF-AU-TH-SG-01 • Facility: Transportation Hub • Frequency: daily

Scope of Work

- Dusting of all sculptures and surrounding areas.
- Sanitising of seating areas and handrails.
- Removal of rubbish and debris from pathways and garden beds.
- Cleaning and polishing of any glass or reflective surfaces.
- Spot cleaning of any spills or stains on hard surfaces.
- Weeding and removal of any organic debris from garden beds.
- Cleaning of signage and information boards.

Method

- 1. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 2. Begin by dusting sculptures with a soft, dry cloth to avoid damage.
- 3. Sanitise seating areas and handrails using a disinfectant spray and cloth.
- 4. Collect rubbish using a trolley and dispose of it in designated rubbish bins.
- 5. Clean glass surfaces with a glass cleaner and microfibre cloth.
- 6. Spot clean spills with appropriate cleaning agents based on the surface type.
- 7. Remove weeds manually or with appropriate tools, ensuring no damage to sculptures.
- 8. Wipe down signage with a damp cloth and mild detergent.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible dust or debris on sculptures; all surfaces sanitised and free of marks; pathways clear of rubbish; glass surfaces streak-free; no weeds present.
Good	Minor dust on sculptures; surfaces mostly sanitised; minimal rubbish on pathways; glass surfaces mostly streak-free; few weeds present.
Pass	Noticeable dust on sculptures; some surfaces not sanitised; some rubbish on pathways; glass surfaces have streaks; several weeds present.
Fail	Heavy dust on sculptures; surfaces unsanitised; rubbish accumulation on pathways; glass surfaces dirty; many weeds present.
