# **Staff Parking**

Code: ANCMF-AU-TH-SP-01 • Facility: Transportation Hub • Frequency: daily

#### **Scope of Work**

- Remove all rubbish and debris from the parking area.
- Sweep and mop all hard surfaces.
- Sanitise high-touch surfaces such as handrails and lift buttons.
- Clean and sanitise any public seating areas.
- Ensure all rubbish bins are emptied and cleaned.
- Remove any graffiti or stains from surfaces.
- Check and clean signage for visibility and cleanliness.

#### Method

- 1. Conduct an initial inspection to identify areas requiring attention.
- 2. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 3. Remove rubbish using a trolley and dispose of it in designated waste areas.
- 4. Sweep the area with a broom, followed by mopping with a suitable detergent.
- 5. Sanitise high-touch surfaces using an approved sanitising solution.
- 6. Inspect and clean all signage and seating areas.
- 7. Perform a final inspection to ensure all tasks are completed to standard.

## **Quality Criteria**

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible rubbish or debris; surfaces are spotless and sanitised; high-touch areas are free of fingerprints and smudges; bins are empty and clean; signage is clear and legible.
Good	Minor rubbish or debris present; surfaces are mostly clean with minor marks; high-touch areas have minimal fingerprints; bins are emptied but may have minor residue; signage is mostly clear.
Pass	Some rubbish or debris present; surfaces have visible marks; high-touch areas have noticeable fingerprints; bins are not overflowing but have visible residue; signage is legible but dirty.
Fail	Significant rubbish or debris present; surfaces are dirty; high-touch areas are heavily marked; bins are overflowing; signage is obscured or unreadable.
