Tarmac

Code: ANCMF-AU-TH-T-04 • Facility: Transportation Hub • Frequency: daily

Scope of Work

- Remove all debris and rubbish from the tarmac area.
- Pressure wash the tarmac surface to remove stains and spills.
- Sanitise high-touch areas such as handrails and benches.
- Inspect and clean all drains and gutters to prevent blockages.
- Ensure all rubbish bins are emptied and sanitised.
- Check and clean any signage for visibility and cleanliness.

Method

- 1. Conduct a preliminary inspection to identify areas requiring attention.
- 2. Use a high-pressure washer to clean the tarmac surface, focusing on stained or heavily soiled areas.
- 3. Apply a suitable sanitising solution to high-touch areas and allow to air dry.
- 4. Manually remove debris from drains and gutters, ensuring water flow is unobstructed.
- 5. Empty rubbish bins, replace liners, and sanitise the bin surfaces.
- 6. Wipe down signage with a damp cloth and mild detergent to ensure visibility.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	No visible debris or stains; all high-touch areas sanitised; bins are clean and odour-free; signage is spotless and legible.
Good	Minor debris present; most high-touch areas sanitised; bins are mostly clean with minimal odour; signage is mostly clean and legible.
Pass	Some debris present; some high-touch areas sanitised; bins have some odour; signage is readable but not entirely clean.
Fail	Significant debris or stains present; high-touch areas not sanitised; bins are dirty and odorous; signage is dirty and illegible.
