Taxiway

Scope of Work

- Remove all debris and foreign objects from the taxiway surface.
- Sanitise all taxiway markings to ensure visibility and safety.
- Conduct a thorough inspection for any spills or stains and clean accordingly.
- Ensure all drainage systems are free from blockages and clean.
- Maintain cleanliness around lighting fixtures and signage.
- Regularly check and clean any adjacent areas such as taxiway shoulders.

Method

- 1. Conduct a visual inspection of the taxiway to identify areas requiring cleaning.
- 2. Use a colour-coded cleaning system to organise tasks and prevent cross-contamination.
- 3. Utilise a trolley equipped with necessary cleaning supplies to efficiently manage the cleaning process.
- 4. Remove debris using appropriate tools and dispose of in designated rubbish bins.
- 5. Sanitise markings and surfaces using approved cleaning agents.
- 6. Inspect and clean drainage systems to ensure proper function.
- 7. Document all cleaning activities and report any issues to the supervisor.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	Taxiway is free from all debris, stains, and spills; markings are clearly visible and sanitised; drainage systems are clean and unblocked; adjacent areas are spotless.
Good	Minor debris present but does not affect safety; markings are visible; minor blockages in drainage systems; adjacent areas are mostly clean.
Pass	Some debris present; markings are visible but not fully sanitised; drainage systems have minor blockages; adjacent areas require attention.
Fail	Significant debris present; markings are obscured; drainage systems are blocked; adjacent areas are dirty.
