Waste Management

Scope of Work

- Regular removal of waste from rubbish bins and disposal in designated areas.
- Sanitising of rubbish bins and surrounding areas to prevent odours and contamination.
- Cleaning and sanitising of waste storage areas, including floors and walls.
- Inspection and cleaning of waste disposal equipment and trolleys.
- Monitoring and managing waste segregation according to recycling and hazardous waste guidelines.
- Immediate response to spills or leaks in waste management areas.

Method

- 1. Collect all waste from bins using a colour-coded system to prevent cross-contamination.
- 2. Transport waste to designated disposal areas using a trolley.
- 3. Sanitise bins and surrounding areas with appropriate cleaning agents.
- 4. Clean floors and walls in waste storage areas using mops and disinfectants.
- 5. Inspect and clean waste disposal equipment and trolleys, ensuring they are free from debris and contamination.
- 6. Ensure waste is segregated and disposed of according to local council and environmental regulations.
- 7. Respond promptly to any spills or leaks, using absorbent materials and disinfectants to clean affected areas.

Quality Criteria

Performance Level	Criteria
Excellent	All bins are emptied and sanitised; no visible waste or odours; floors and walls are spotless; waste equipment is clean and operational; waste is correctly segregated.
Good	Bins are emptied and sanitised; minor waste or odours present; floors and walls are mostly clean; waste equipment is mostly clean; waste is mostly segregated correctly.
Pass	Bins are emptied; some waste or odours present; floors and walls have some dirt; waste equipment is functional but not fully clean; waste segregation is inconsistent.
Fail	Bins are not emptied; significant waste or odours present; floors and walls are dirty; waste equipment is dirty or non-functional; waste is not segregated.
